Spiritual Solutions is "Transitional Housing for recovering drug and alcohol users." It was established in 2019 under the leadership of Sarah Counts, Margie Pinnell and Wayne Dupre.

The mission of Spiritual Solutions is to offer their clients an opportunity to build new relationships and habits. The program requires a 12 step meeting attendance, employment, respect for others and accountability.

They offer affordable housing and employment assistance for both men and women.

There is a \$200 deposit and a self supporting payment of \$100 a week to cover rent and electric.

I would like to see our church offer assistance twice a year - January and July. This support will be helping with their personal items such as soap, shampoo, toothpaste, cleaning supplies like dish soap, laundry soap, etc. They are responsible for their own living quarters.

Donations of good used clothing can be taken to the Exchange located on Main Street here in Sullivan. Sarah has an account there for their clients that come with nothing of their own. They are able to go and pick out items they need.

"Lead Like Jesus" <u>New Bible Study</u>

Greg Myers introduced 12 members to a new Bible Study class "Lead Like Jesus" at 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, January 21st. The class will be held each Sunday at that time for 7 weeks. 
